Dear Parent/Guardians,

We were notified of another positive COVID case at Rostraver Elementary School today. There was no need to do contact tracing because of when this person was last in the building. This does make the 5<sup>th</sup> case at Rostraver Elementary School. As a reminder, as of right now, both elementary buildings will be back to in-person instruction on Monday, May 3, 2021. The buildings have been cleaned and aired out to make it safe for students and staff to return.

What are the signs and symptoms of COVID 19? Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus and may range from mild to severe.

Symptoms include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

We are following the recommendations from the PA Department of Health and the PA Department of Education, as the health and wellness of our students and our community are always our highest priority. Please stay safe.
